

ILTON PARISH COUNCIL

SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CONDITIONS FOR THE CEMETERY

From - 1st December 2017

The standard parishioners fees set out below apply

1. Where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted, is, or immediately before his/her death was a Parishioner of Ilton ,or
2. Where the person has moved out of Ilton to go into a Nursing or Residential Home, Hospital or stay with a relative, for a period not exceeding 10 years.

In all other non parishioner cases the fees will be doubled.

Special conditions

1. In the case of a still born child the fee for interment can be waived with the authority of the Parish Council
2. If selection of a site for interment creates a problem, the Parish Council to give a ruling.
3. The Council will not normally undertake responsibility for grave maintenance. Any exception to this policy, because of special circumstances, to be referred to the Parish Council for a decision.

A headstone not exceeding 3ft 6 inches in height 2. Any monument not exceeding 6' in height 3. For every inscription after the first 4. Removing and replacing any monument for any reason, including subsequent interment <p>NOTE: Kerbing stone surrounds and flat stones will not be allowed on any graves.</p> <p><u>Cremation Plots:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A headstone not exceeding 2 feet in height (maximum width of base to be no more than 2 feet) 2. For every inscription after the first 3. Removing and replacing any monument for any reason, including subsequent interment. <p>NOTE: Kerbing stone surrounds and flat stones will not be allowed on any graves.</p>
